Construction Permit Certifications - Environmental Effect

The proposed facility will not have a significant environmental impact and complies with the maximum permissible radiofrequency electromagnetic exposure limits for controlled and uncontrolled environments.

The proposed facility is not subject to Routine Environmental Evaluation, as it will operate with less than 100 watts.

The proposed facility is not likely to be visited by the public. Signs are being installed at the proposed site that alert persons to the presence of RF electromagnetic fields and warn them not to remain for an extended period. In addition, the property containing the proposed facility is surrounded by fencing.

The applicant also certifies that it, in coordination with other users of the site, will reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic exposure in excess of FCC guidelines.
