The proposal is still predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

The allowable interference to a Full Service TV Station is 0.50%, whereas the amended specifications did not resolve the interference issue to the allowable or lower percentage; therefore, the above proposal 0000014032 IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
