

DEMONSTRATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH COMMUNITY OF LICENSE COVERAGE RULES

This application proposes a channel sharing arrangement between WNVN(TV), Goldvein, VA (Fac. ID 10019) and WCVE-TV, Richmond, VA (Fac. ID 9987), whereby WNVN will broadcast using WCVE-TV's transmission facilities.


Under Section 73.625(a) of the Commission's Rules, a full power UHF television station's DTV transmitter must provide a 48 dBu contour over the station's entire principal community to be served. As demonstrated in the attached technical statement of engineering consultant Joseph M. Davis, P.E., WCVE-TV's 48 dBu contour does not cover WNVN's principal community of Goldvein, VA. However, in the Incentive Auction Report and Order, the Commission determined that sharees "may propose licensed community changes if they cannot satisfy signal coverage requirements from their new transmitter sites, provided that the new communities meet the same allotment priorities as the current ones and are located in the same Designated Market Areas." *In the Matter of Expanding the Econ. & Innovation Opportunities of Spectrum Through Incentive Auctions*, Report & Order, 29 FCC Rcd. 6567 ¶¶ 27, 374-77 (2014). The Commission further stated that "[i]n the unlikely event that the sharee cannot identify any community that meets the same or a higher allotment priority at its new shared site, it must choose a new community of license to which it will provide the next highest priority." *Id.* ¶ 376 n. 1117.

Upon commencement of channel sharing, WNVN proposes to change its community of license to Spotsylvania Courthouse, Virginia (also known as Spotsylvania, Virginia). Spotsylvania Courthouse is the county seat of Spotsylvania County, Virginia, with a 2010 U.S. Census population of 4,239 persons, its own schools, as well as numerous religious institutions and businesses. *See In the Matter of Amendment of Section 73.622(I), Post-Transition Table of DTV Allotments*, 26 FCC Rcd. 32 (MB 2011). Spotsylvania Courthouse and Goldvein are both located in the Washington, D.C. (Hagerstown) Designated Market Area. Moreover, as demonstrated in the attached technical statement of Joseph M. Davis, P.E., although WCVE-TV's 48 dBu predicted contour does not cover Spotsylvania Courthouse in its entirety, a supplemental Longley-Rice analysis demonstrates that WCVE-TV places a 48-dBu signal over all of Spotsylvania Courthouse. *See KNTJ License Inc.* 19 FCC Rcd. 15479, 15484 (MB 2004) (establishing community of license coverage through Longley-Rice analysis); *In the Matter of Definition of Markets for Purposes of the Cable Television Broad. Signal Carriage Rules*, 14 FCC Rcd. 8366 (1999) (recognizing that "[t]he Longley-Rice model provides a more accurate representation of a station's technical coverage area because it takes into account such factors as mountains and valleys that are not specifically reflected in a traditional Grade B contour analysis").

Finally, Spotsylvania Courthouse meets the same allotment priority as Goldvein. The Commission's allotment priorities are to: (1) provide at least one television service to all parts of the country; (2) provide each community with at least one television broadcast station; (3) provide a choice of at least two television services to all parts of the country; (4) provide each community with at least two television broadcast stations; and (5) assign any remaining channels to communities based on population, geographic location, and the number of television services available to the community from stations located in other communities. *Amendment of Section 3.606 of the Commission's Rules and*

Regulations, Sixth Report and Order, 41 FCC 148, 167 (1952). As demonstrated in the attached report from BIA/Kelsey, WNVT currently provides a first local service to Goldvein, placing it in allotment priority 2. With the proposed change, WNVT would provide a first local service to Spotsylvania Courthouse, placing it in the same allotment priority. Accordingly, the proposed change is consistent with the Incentive Auction Rules and Section 307(b) of the Communications Act.






