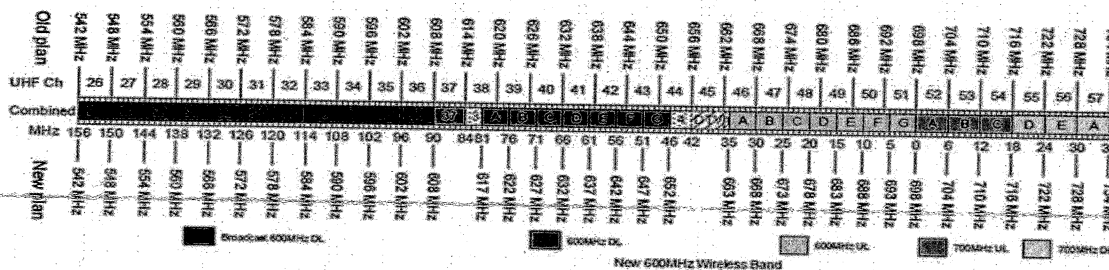
Re: Notification of T-Mobile Deployment in the 600MHz Band for BAS Licensees

Dear WQJW296 Licensee:

T-Mobile USA Inc., is planning to deploy commercial wireless services in our owned spectrum blocks in the 600MHz band. T-Mobile's engineering team has conducted studies to identify potential harmful interference from Point to Point and Point Radius BAS licensees currently in our 600MHz bands. Those studies have indicated that continued operation by WQJW296 on its current channel is likely to cause harmful interference to T-Mobile operations. Per FCC regulations 47 CFR 74.602(h)(5) we are notifying you of the predicted interference and request that you vacate the 600MHz band in the next 30 days.

For your information, the following chart illustrates how the new wireless band (71) overlays with the existing UHF channels 38-51. We wish to minimize interference with the wireless base stations and handsets that will operate in the new band and we want to avoid disruptions to any other operations currently in use.
