

Request for Waiver of Construction Permit Application Filing Deadline

Pursuant to Section 1.3 of the FCC's Rules, Teleadoracion Christian Network Inc. ("TCN"), the licensee of WDWL (DT), Bayamon, PR (Facility ID No. 4110) ("Station"), hereby requests waiver of Section 73.3700(b)(3)(1)(i) of the Commission's Rules to allow WDWL an additional 3 months in which to file an application for a license of a shared channel.

TCN submitted a successful bid in the recently completed incentive auction for the Station to return its spectrum and go off-air. In the FCC Form 177 it submitted as part of the incentive auction process, TCN advised that its intent was to enter into a channel sharing agreement ("CSA").

TCN then executed a CSA with Caguas Educational TV, Inc., licensee of WUJA (DT), Caguas, PR (Facility ID No. 8156), to share facilities with WUJA (DT). However, WUJA has continued to experience difficulties due to the damage caused by Hurricane Mario in Puerto Rico. WUJA has recently extended its STA due to ongoing electricity issues (File No. 0000048957).

TCN requests a waiver of its Construction Permit. The FCC may grant a waiver for good cause shown. The agency typically grants a waiver where the particular facts make strict compliance inconsistent with the public interest. *N.E. Cellular Tel. Co. v. FCC*, 897 F.2d 1164, 1166 (D.C. Cir. 1990).

Grant of this waiver request is clearly in the public interest, as it will allow a Puerto Rican station to recover from the difficulties resulting from Hurricane Maria. Moreover, granting of this waiver will not impact the post-incentive auction transition. Accordingly, TCN requests an extension of an additional 3 months of its CP.
