

Amendment of 1st Quarter 2018 Children's Programming Report

Station: KFWD-TV, Facility #29015, Fort Worth, TX

This Amendment is being filed to correct the following issues that were identified following the initial filing of the 1Q 2018 Children's Program Report.

Missing E/I Bug

Subsequent to the initial filing of the report, the licensee was advised by SonLife Broadcasting Network that, due to a technical error which has since been corrected, the E/I bug did not appear on screen during 1 hour of "rescheduled" E/I programming, "Generation of the Cross" on Saturday, March 31, 9AM. This Amendment revises the average number of hours per week of Core Programming broadcast by the station on its main program stream.

Episode Repeats > 50%

The licensee normally delays episodes of E/I programming on sub-channel 52.5 by 12 days from when the same episodes are broadcast on other sub-channels. However, due to an error in program scheduling, all 78 episodes of E/I programming on sub-channel 52.5 that aired in the 8 am to 11 am time block each Tuesday during Q1 2018 were broadcast only 5 days after those same episodes had been aired on Thursday of the previous week on sub-channel 52.4. As a result, out of a total of 234 half-hour episodes of E/I spread among the station's three sub-channels during the quarter, 78 episodes were unintentionally repeated within 7 days, while an additional 78 episodes were intentionally repeated, resulting in a total of 156 episode repeats, which is 66.7% of the total E/I programming aired during the quarter. This scheduling error was discovered in the first week of May 2018. Corrective action has been taken to reduce the number of repeat episodes to zero for the remainder of Q2 2018, which will result in the average number of repeats over the two-quarter period of Q1 and Q2 2018 being below the 50% threshold. Note that the scheduling error described above began during the fourth quarter 2017, however a review of data from that quarter determined that the number of repeat episodes remained below 50% despite the unintended repetition of some episodes, so no amendment of the 4Q 2017 report is required.
