Pursuant to conversations WLS has had with Jeremy Ruck & Associates, Vertical Bridge and the Willis Tower team regarding the possibility that WLS will complete its post-auction transition in Phase 6, rather than Phase 8. This letter is to confirm that the WLS's transition in Phase 6 will not adversely impact the ability of Willis Tower to implement the repacking with respect to other television stations seeking to transition to their post-auction channels. As you know, Jeremy Ruck & Associates is working with the television stations with transmitting antennas located at Willis Tower and will have accomplished the repacking at Willis Tower through a variety of means, including the reconfiguration of the broadcast antennas. Presently, Willis Tower intends to have completed construction of facilities for all repacked stations' post-auction channels by the beginning of Phase 6 (by September 7, 2019).
