

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by Ben Jordan Communications Corporation (BJCC), licensee of WQMK-LD, Cusseta, Alabama, and DTV America Corporation (DTV), licensee of W43CW-D, Columbus, Georgia. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, the stations agree to accept interference from each other, the effect of which would eliminate the mutual exclusivity between the two pending applications, the only applications in MX Group 21.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, engineering amendment, and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, both applications are hereby **GRANTED**.
