

Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by HC2 LPTV Holdings, Inc. (HC2), licensee of K31GL-D, De Soto, Texas; The Edge Spectrum, Inc. (ESI), licensee of K31MU-D, Lingleville-Crowley, Texas; New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC (NSHC), licensee of KVFW-LD, Fort Worth, Texas; and Ventana Television, Inc. (VTI), licensee of K25FW-D, Corsicana, Texas. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, the stations agree to accept interference from each other, the effect of which would eliminate the mutual exclusivity between the four pending applications, the only applications in MX Group 60.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, amendments, and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, all of the applications are hereby **GRANTED**.
