
Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC (NY Spectrum), licensee of KQHO-LD, Houston, Texas; Word Broadcasting Network (WBN), licensee of KBPX-LD, Houston, Texas; and Gray Television Licensee, LLC, (Gray), licensee of K49LC-D, College Station, Texas. You have submitted settlement agreements to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to a settlement agreement, NY Spectrum has agreed to dismiss its application and will channel share with WBN on KBPX-LD's displacement channel

facilities. In addition, pursuant to settlement agreement, Gray has agreed to amend its application to reduce interference with WBN's displacement channel facilities. These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among all of the applicants in MX Group 70.

Upon review of your settlement agreements, engineering amendment and related documents, we find that they comply with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, the applications for WBN and Gray are hereby **GRANTED** and the application of NY Spectrum is hereby **DISMISSED**.
