

## **PURPOSE OF STA**

The purpose of this STA application is to allow the WNTZ-DT facility to temporarily operate with alternate parameters on its pre-transition channel (49) using a side-mounted directional interim antenna (TFU-16WB S230) while the new post-transition main antenna is installed. The proposed WNTZ interim facility at reduced parameters will completely encompass its community of license with the F(50,90) 48.0 dBu principal community contour and will not exceed its licensed F(50,90) 41.91 dBu pre-transition protected noise limited contour in any azimuthal direction (see showing below).
