

Affidavit Bryan Switzer

State of Texas, County of Dallas:

My name is Bryan Switzer. I am an independent contractor retained by ONE Media 3.0, LLC to help facilitate the deployment of ATSC 3.0 in the Dallas, Texas market and an associated single frequency network platform.

I have been informed that low power station K48NY-D, licensed to the John R. Powley Irrevocable Trust, has authority to operate in Gainesville, Texas on Channel 48 with a power level of 0.1kW ERP – Facility ID 128569. My review of the FCC license database disclosed that the station was licensed on 6-11-13 to operate at the following coordinates:

33.623868, -97.128385, Gainesville, Texas.

A modification application was granted on 4-13-15 changing the coordinates for transmitter operation to:

33.345389, -96.643028, Celina, Texas

On March 5, 2019, I travelled to both locations to conduct over-the-air testing of the broadcast signal of K48NY-D. Using a RCA amplified flat HDTV multi-directional antenna and a LG UHD TV monitor, Model 43UK60, I conducted tests to determine if the K48NY-D signal was receivable. The test conditions were sunny, clear skies, wind calm, temperature at test 39 degrees.


At the Celina location, I placed the antenna approximately seven feet above ground, rescanned the television monitor, entered Channel 48 on the remote control, and the television went to channel 49-1, Unimas, Dallas, transmitted by KSTR. I moved the antenna in all directions and the only signal received was 49-1 (actual 48). I was not able to receive any signal from K48NY-D.

Even though K48NY-D was authorized to move closer to Dallas at the Celina location, I travelled to the original Gainesville location to test for the signal there as well. I rescanned the television monitor and placed the antenna approximately seven feet above ground, entered Channel 48 on the remote control and could not receive Channel 48. I moved antenna in all directions and the receiver could not acquire any Channel 48 signal.

I contacted the licensee by telephone at the number reflected on the K48NY-D license and spoke with Caroline Smith, who informed me that she was the daughter of now-deceased John Powley, the beneficiary of the trust licensee. She noted to me that she was unaware of any station operation in the Dallas area.

The Celina licensed coordinates are located in a rural ranch designated as the "JW Ranch." During my testing, I drove to the ranch and did not observe any transmission equipment or antenna facilities. I was informed by an individual at the ranch that he was unaware of any television station transmit operation.

I hereby state that the information above is true, to the best of my knowledge. I also confirm that the information here is both accurate and complete, and relevant information has not been omitted.
