This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by New York Spectrum Holding Company, LLC (NY Spectrum), licensee of KVHD-LD, Los Angeles, California, and KJLA, LLC (KJLA), licensee of KSGA-LD, Los Angeles, California. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, NY Spectrum has agreed to dismiss its application and will channel share with KJLA on KSGA-LD's displacement channel facilities.
