Thanks for taking my call Friday afternoon, vacation and all.

Recapping what we discussed on the phone for the record, I am the technical representative for KALO-TV in Honolulu. The station seems to be in a time crunch trying to meet the April 12, 2019 due date to move from channel 38 to 18 as required by terms of the FCC 600 MHz spectrum auction. This is due to a combination of a tower/antenna partnership that failed to progress and a subsequent late transmitter order. We have an FCC-granted Special Temporary Authority to remain on our current/interim site on channel 18, but not yet FCC approval yet to extend our repack Construction Permit.

Our interim broadband antenna is in place and a new transmitter was ordered 6 weeks ago, but it has not yet arrived.

We're asking for your forbearance in allowing us to occupy channel 38 in the Honolulu metro market until April 30, 2019 if needed to receive, test, and switch our transmission to channel 18.
