

CONSTRUCTION PERMIT CERTIFICATION RESPONSE

The station's proposed change will result in its post-incentive auction facility slightly expanding its noise-limited service contour in several azimuthal directions beyond that established by the post-incentive auction channel reassignment public notice; however, the expansion is below 1% (0.8%) due to the antenna change and TVStudy demonstrates that the facility will not cause impermissible interference to any stations.
