## Dear Applicants:

This concerns the above-referenced displacement applications for digital low power television stations filed by Caribevision Holdings, Inc. (CHI), licensee of WFUN-LD, Miami, Florida; Paging Systems, Inc. (PSI), licensee of WLMF-LD, Miami, Florida; and KRCA License, LLC (KRCA), licensee of W24DE-D, Miami, Florida. You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, CHI and KRCA have agreed to dismiss their applications and to the grant of PSI's

application.<sup>1</sup> These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among the only applications in MX Group 11.

Upon review of your settlement agreement, engineering amendment and related documents, we find that it complies with Section 311(c) of the Communications Act, Section 73.3525 and the Commission's technical rules. Wherefore, the application of PSI (File No. 0000052578) is hereby **GRANTED** and the applications of CHI and KRCA (File Nos. 0000052533 and 0000053956) are hereby **DISMISSED**.
