
Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a modification to a licensed facility.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807. Specifically, the site proposed is located 7 kilometers from the licensed facilities of WERQ-FM (BLH-20130830ACP) on channel 222B and WPOC(FM) (BLH-20180312AAT) on channel 226B. The required spacing pursuant to § 73.807 is 67 kilometers. The application fails to address these defects.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application 88161 is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
