Internship Program – Continuation of an extensive on-going licensee internship program. The opportunity for an internship with WNXP FM and WZEW FM is offered to all students enrolled in an institution of higher learning. Occasionally, the stations will make an exception and allow individuals who are not enrolled in an institution of higher learning. The stations submitted internship information to the local colleges in and near Mobile County. The internships available and filled in 2018 included internships in the areas of communication, news and public affairs, support services, radio and production. As of this report, WNXP and WZEW have 4 interns working on-site and 6 others worked this past year. The intern pool included both male and female applicants. Upon approval of a student's respective institution of higher learning, a student intern may receive credit for the internship. A midterm and final evaluation has been created by the stations to forward to the intern's respective institution of higher learning, should one be required.
