

## **FCC License Renewal**

### **Station WBTJ**

#### **Renewal Certifications**

Licensee acquired the station on December 19, 2017. *See* FCC File No. BAL-20171102ABD. In accordance with the Instructions to this Form 2100 – Schedule 303-S, the certifications made in this application cover only the period of time from and after such date.

#### **Public Inspection File**

The station was not required to transition to the online public file until March 1, 2018, which, as noted above, was after Licensee acquired the station. To the extent Licensee received historical public file documentation from the previous licensee, Licensee uploaded the required historical documents to the online public file.

As part of Licensee's internal public file review practices, as well as in connection with preparing to submit this license renewal application, Licensee discovered that certain documents, including those identified below, were either missing from the online public file or not uploaded in a timely manner.

All missing documents have since been uploaded to the public file. The missing and/or late documents included:

- Political Files: Certain documentation required to be in the political file was not immediately uploaded to the file.
- Quarterly Issues/Programs Reports: Following Licensee's acquisition of the station, it discovered that WBTJ-HD2 was not airing issue responsive programming. Licensee began airing issue responsive programming on WBTJ-HD2 in the second quarter of 2018. An automation error, which has since been fixed, prevented the issue responsive programming from airing on WBTJ-HD2 in the fourth quarter of 2018. In addition, due to an inadvertent oversight, the quarterly issues/programs reports for WBTJ-HD3 were not timely uploaded to the public file.

Licensee believes, to the best of its knowledge, that all other documentation required to be uploaded to the online public file has been uploaded in compliance with Section 73.3526 of the Commission's rules in all material respects.
