Dear Counsel:

On May 4, 2011, Media General Communications Holdings, LLC (Media General), filed a petition for rulemaking to substitute channel 29 for channel 11 in the Post-Transition Table of DTV Allotments for station WJHL-TV, Johnson City, Tennessee. Media General is no longer the licensee of WJHL-TV, which is now licensed to Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc. In addition, the proposal to substitute channel 29 at Jackson causes impermissible interference to the channel 28 repacked facility assigned to WMET, Greeneville, Tennessee, during the incentive auction and repacking process.¹

Accordingly, the above-referenced rulemaking petition IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
