

Honorable Commissioners,

Max Henry & Associates respectfully request commission approval to convert WFHD-TX from analog to digital; be allowed to convert from Channel 27 to Channel 30 due to the displacement by FCC Repacking, where WADL-TV was assigned Channel 27 which was at the time, assigned to WFHD-LPTV; permission to a status upgrade from translator to low power television outlet. With these changes, Max Henry & Associates will better meet the needs of the community it serves.

With the conversion from analog to digital, the quality of audio and visual will greatly improve as well as fulfill the FCC mandate.

Following a critical search by our engineers, we ask to change channel from 27 to 30 due to or displacement. Channel 30 is also assigned to a low power Canadian television station (CFTV-LP), located in Leamington, Ontario Canada. It should be noted (as it is in the Engineering Section of this application), proper distancing has been made to ensure non-interference neither to the CFTV-LP nor WFHD-LP.

Max Henry & Associates respectfully seeks to change its classification from translator (TX) to low power television (LD), as it will enable the station to provide twenty (24) four hour, seven day (7) a week, live and local programming of entertainment and information. In doing so, the Commission will be granting WFHD-LD to better meet the needs of the community it serves.

Max Henry & Associates humbly and sincerely request the afore mentioned conversions, as it is our intent to be the best steward the FCC seeks and the community deserves, which we serve.
