

Special Temporary Authority

DTV America Corporation (“Licensee”) respectfully requests a Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to remain silent while it repairs its permanent broadcast facility’s transmitter for this Low Power Television (“LPTV”) station. The FCC has a history of granting such requests, particularly where, as here, the request is supported by good cause and granting it would further the public interest.

Moreover, granting this request would not implicate Section 312(g) of the Act, which generally limits silent station authorizations to 12 months.¹ The STA is for an initial period of six months and, if extended by an additional six months as requested, would not exceed this 12 month limit.

For these reasons, the Media Bureau should expeditiously grant Licensee’s request for an STA to remain silent while it repairs its permanent broadcast facility.
