INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

All WKMS full and part time staff and student interns participate in an annual university-mandated harassment and discrimination training via online modules on which the participant must score 100%

The Station Manager and Membership Director participated in MSU Career Fairs at Curris Center on 10/16/18 and 3/05/2019, soliciting resumes and explaining part-time position availability.

WKMS has an ongoing paid intern program for MSU Students, working up to 20 hours a week. Some are trained to produce news meeting NPR standards. Others work in operations, promotions or administrative capacities with WKMS staff. WKMS also intakes volunteer producers who are trained as on-air presenters.

October 17, 2018 –Station Manager presented a Leadership Tomorrow program for Juniors and Seniors from Murray and Calloway County High Schools.
