

PURPOSE OF PRE-AUCTION ENGINEERING STA

The purpose of this Pre-Auction Engineering STA application is to allow the WFMY-DT facility to temporarily operate with alternate parameters on its pre-auction channel (51) using a side-mounted directional <u>interim antenna</u> (TFU-8WB-R C160) while the new <u>post-auction main facility</u> continues to be built-out. The proposed WFMY pre-auction interim facility at reduced parameters will completely encompass its community of license with the F(50,90) 48.0 dBu principal community contour and will not exceed its licensed F(50,90) 42.06 dBu pre-auction protected noise limited contour in any azimuthal direction (see showing below).
