

Additional 1.0 Station Hosts for WPNT Multicast Streams

WCWB Licensee, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of WPNT(TV), Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania (Facility ID 73907; RF Channel 21), is filing this application to (1) commence ATSC 3.0 operations from WPNT’s current facility and (2) identify host stations that will simulcast WPNT’s programming in ATSC 1.0 format.

As indicated in the Form 2100 application, Licensee proposes to simulcast WPNT’s primary stream (affiliated with *MyNetwork*) in ATSC 1.0 format on commonly owned **WPGH-TV**, Pittsburgh, PA (Facility ID 73875; RF Channel 20).

By this exhibit, and to ensure that WPNT’s transition to ATSC 3.0 will not result in any loss of over the air programming to viewers, Licensee hereby identifies an additional host station that will simulcast the programming currently airing on WPNT’s multicast streams in ATSC 1.0 format: **WTAE-TV**, Pittsburgh, PA (Facility ID 65681; RF Channel 22), licensed to Hearst Stations Inc., will simulcast WPNT’s *Stadium*, *Comet TV*, and *TBD* streams, pursuant to a written simulcast agreement.

The PSIP virtual channels for each of WPNT’s program streams described herein will remain unchanged. Accordingly, WPNT’s streams will be hosted in ATSC 1.0 as follows:

To the extent that Commission approval is required for additional simulcast arrangements, Licensee respectfully requests such approval. In addition, out of an abundance of caution, Licensee is simultaneously filing a request for Special Temporary Authority for approval to relocate WPNT’s multicast programming streams’ ATSC 1.0 signals in accordance with the simulcast arrangements described herein.
