

### WSRT Public File Documents

All of the required documents have been placed in the station's public files during the license term. A few documents were posted a bit after the due date, however. These include the issues/programs list for the first quarter of 2018, which was posted in the online public file on April 11, 2018, one day late. Additionally, the issues/programs list for the third quarter of 2018 was posted on October 30, 2018, 20 days late. Both of these slight delays were due to inadvertent oversight and unfamiliarity with posting in the online public file.

The issues/programs list for the fourth quarter of 2018 was posted on May 5, 2020, when the licensee recognized that it had inadvertently not been posted when due. The issue with this report is that although it was prepared on December 2018, by the time of the normal posting deadline, the Federal government was closing due to funding issues, and the report deadline was postponed until February 8, 2019. At that time, WSRT was a part of a larger station group than is now the case, and the majority of the issues/programs lists for those stations were posted in February 2019. For two stations, however, one of which was WSRT, the licensee's staff, for reasons which it cannot now recall, overlooked the fact that it had not successfully posted the issues/programs list to the online public file.

Finally, although the licensee now has shrunk to fewer than five full-time employees, largely due to the sale of stations and financial issues, in prior years during the license term, the station's employment unit had more than five full-time employees and thus was then required to file public file reports. The 2018-19 EEO public file report for the employment unit was posted to the online public file on June 14, 2019, 13 days late, due to an inadvertent oversight.
