

## **WUNU's Final Transition Plan Progress Report (Construction Completion)**

We are pleased to report that on May 29, 2020, WUNU began operating its full power final post-transition facility. As a result, on May 29, 2020, WUNU submitted a license application, LMS File No. [0000114990](#), for the final WUNU post-transition facility. Previously, WUNU ceased operation on its pre-transition channel and began operating on its post-transition channel, channel 30, on January 17, 2020, which was the Phase 7 deadline. On that day, WUNU began operating using interim facilities from its licensed auxiliary facility (LMS File No. [0000098031](#)).

While the WUNU repack transition project has progressed to a point to allow for the license application for the final WUNU facility to be submitted, we want to make clear that a few tasks remain to be performed before the overall repack project can truly be considered completed. The most significant of those tasks is the completion of the tower plumb and tension measurements and adjustments. This will confirm that the tower conforms to the structural specifications outlined in the most recent tower structural analysis. Other work on the project including the building infrastructure modifications and the transmitter installations have been completed.

UNC-TV will be submitting additional budget updates for FCC Form 399. Among other things, these updates may include additional installation costs, and professional services expenses. UNC-TV will also continue to submit FCC Form 399 reimbursement requests in a timely manner as it receives invoices that qualify for reimbursement.
