

## Online Public Inspection File

Note the following regarding the “No” response to this certification: “Licensee certifies that the documentation required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3526 or 73.3527, as applicable, has been uploaded to the station's public inspection file as and when required.”

Great Lakes Radio - Detroit, LLC (“Great Lakes Radio”) acquired WMKM(AM), 1440 kHz, Inkster, Michigan, on October 6, 2014, pursuant to the grant of an assignment application on Form 314 (“long-form”), File No. BAL-20140625ANY. As set forth in the Instructions to Form 2100, Schedule 303-S, if the station license was assigned during the subject license term pursuant to a “long-form” application on FCC Form 314 or 315, the renewal applicant’s certifications should cover only the period during which the renewal applicant held the station’s license. Consequently, the certifications of Great Lakes Radio in this renewal application and the associated Form 2100, Schedule 396, relate to the period commencing on October 6, 2014.

WMKM(AM) is a “Mom and Pop” owned and operated AM station, serving its community with broadcasts of Christian news, plus local traffic, news and weather, in addition to gospel music. As a station employment unit with fewer than five full-time employees during the applicable period, WMKM(AM) was not required to transition to its online public inspection file until March 1, 2018. All pre-2018 quarterly issues-programs lists since the station acquisition during the Fourth Quarter 2014 were uploaded to WMKM(AM)’s online public inspection file by the March 1, 2018 deadline. However, due to a misunderstanding as to the upload schedule, the quarterly issues-programs lists for 2018 and 2019 were not uploaded until January 2020. (The First Quarter 2020 quarterly issues-programs list has been uploaded in advance of the extended July 10, 2020 deadline.) Mr. Gallagher, the owner, Member and Manager of Great Lakes Radio, has added calendar reminders to ensure timely uploads of the quarterly lists going forward.
