

Online Public Inspection File WUSW(FM)

In reviewing the station's online public file in preparation for this renewal, the licensee noted that a few issues/programs ("I/P") lists were uploaded a few days late. The licensee also noted that the I/P list for 4Q 2012 was never uploaded, perhaps as much of that quarter was in the prior renewal cycle. That list has since been uploaded. It is also noted that, in 2015, the station that is now WQLZ and the commonly owned station that is now WUSW swapped formats, and the call letters WQLZ migrated from one station to another. In uploading the I/P lists from the period before the swap, it appears that the I/P lists for the station that was then WLCE (now WQLZ) were uploaded to the file of the station that is now WUSW, and that the files for the station that is was then WQLZ were uploaded to the files of the station that is now WQLZ. In other words, the reports followed the format, not the Facility ID Number for the stations in question. This probably makes more logical sense to listeners who followed the formats of the stations, but is noted here as these files may not have been technically uploaded to the right station file.

Finally, licensee discovered that in 2018, not all documents were uploaded to the political file immediately after they were created.
