FCC Violations

As the Commission is aware, on May 30, 2017, TEGNA Inc. (“TEGNA”), as parent of Multimedia Holdings Corporation (“MHC”), the licensee of WTLV, Jacksonville, Florida, entered into a Consent Decree with the Enforcement Bureau to resolve the Commission’s investigation into whether WTLV improperly transmitted Emergency Alert System tones. *See TEGNA Inc., Order & Consent Decree*, File No. EB-IHD-16-00022388, DA 17-424 (EB May 30, 2017) (the “Consent Decree”). For the purpose of the Consent Decree and the Commission’s civil enforcement purposes, TEGNA admitted that WTLV had improperly broadcast simulated EAS tones. In accordance with the Consent Decree, TEGNA established enhanced EAS compliance procedures and training. TEGNA’s and MHC’s reports under the Consent Decree are on file with the Enforcement Bureau in File No. EB-IHD-16-00022388. The Consent Decree expired on May 30, 2020.
