

Antenna Changes

The WLLA construction permit specifies operation with a horizontally polarized antenna. The antenna which was installed, however, is elliptically polarized. Because the electronic filing system won't permit the polarization to be changed in a license application, the attached application continues to specify elliptical polarization and it is requested that the FCC staff correct this in the covering license application.

Details on the antenna which was installed are included in a separate attachment to this application. Because the horizontally polarized effective radiated power and azimuth pattern for this antenna are identical to those specified in the original construction permit application, this modification can be reported in this license application without first modifying the underlying construction permit pursuant to Section 73.1690(c) of the FCC Rules. A separate exhibit attached to this application documents that the as constructed WLLA facilities comply with the FCC's requirements regarding human exposure to nonionizing radiation.
