Discrimination Complaints

WFTV, LLC (“WFTV”) has reviewed its files and records for documents and information relevant to the question on “Discrimination Complaints” in FCC Form 396. Based on the information found and without further investigation, WFTV submits that, to its actual knowledge, the following describes all of the pending or resolved complaints that have been filed during this license term before any body having competent jurisdiction under federal, state, territorial or local law, alleging unlawful discrimination in the employment practices of the stations.

On June 30, 2020, Susan Schmidt filed a Charge of Discrimination against WFTV with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (“EEOC”), Tampa Division, (Charge No. 511-2020-03805), which also has been presented to the Florida Commission on Human Relations. In her Charge, Ms. Schmidt alleges claims of sex and age discrimination and retaliation. WFTV disputes the claims made by Ms. Schmidt and the parties have agreed to submit to mediation in an effort to resolve Ms. Schmidt’s claims. The investigatory process has been stayed pending the outcome of the mediation.
