

Additional Children’s Programming Information

The instant exhibit is to provide some context to a few Children’s Programming Reports (each, a “Report”) that might otherwise not be obvious from a brief glance at the Reports.

First, the First Quarter 2018 Report identifies a Core Programming average for WPBF’s multicast channels as 5.77 per week. When averaged with the previous calendar quarter—the Fourth Quarter 2017 Report identifies a Core Programming average for WPBF’s multicast channels as 6.23 hours per week—it becomes evident that the six-month average is compliant for two multicast channels and that the shortfall in First Quarter 2018 was merely a function of a calendrical anomaly. The same concept holds true for the two-quarter period of Fourth Quarter 2018 and First Quarter 2019.

Second, the annual Report for 2019 may appear from its filing date to have been filed late because it was filed March 27, 2020. In fact, the 2019 annual Report was timely filed by the extended deadline established by the Media Bureau by Public Notice.
