

WQXT-CD Online Public Inspection File

During the last license renewal period, A1A TV, Inc. (“Licensee”), licensee of WQXT-CD, St. Augustine, FL (Facility ID No. 39241) (“WQXT”), cannot certify full compliance with certain Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements with respect to WQXT.

Section 73.3613 Contracts/Documents List. Licensee inadvertently failed to upload the contracts and documents required by Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules to WQXT’s OPIF. Upon discovering this oversight, Licensee promptly uploaded the required documents.

Issues/Programs Lists. WQXT’s Q3 2016 Issues/Programs List was uploaded one day late on October 11, 2016.

Licensee appreciates its obligation to fully comply with the Commission’s rules. However, it believes the public interest was not impacted by the late filing listed above. As an initial matter, Licensee would note that Hurricane Matthew struck Florida in early October 2016. President Obama declared a federal state of emergency in Florida on October 6, and the storm moved through Florida over the course of the next several days. Given those circumstances, Licensee submits that a one day delay in uploading the required report did not harm the public interest. Moreover, as demonstrated by WQXT’s compliance with every other quarterly Issues/Programs List upload deadline, Licensee takes seriously its obligation to comply with the Commission’s rules and has appropriate procedures in place to ensure relevant documents are timely uploaded to the online public inspection file.
