

Alpha Media Licensee, LLC – Fairfield, IA Online Public File

In preparation for filing its license renewal applications, Alpha Media Licensee, LLC (“Alpha”) has conducted audits of the online public inspection files at its radio stations. Having become aware of deficiencies with respect to the timely upload of political advertising information in certain markets, and as the Commission is aware, Alpha, with commitment at the highest corporate levels, redoubled the company’s efforts to train staff consistently and to implement company-wide operating procedures so as to ensure that requisite information is timely uploaded to the online public file in compliance with the Commission’s rules. Alpha submitted documentation of these efforts to the Commission in April 2020 and entered into a consent decree with the Commission on July 22. In Alpha’s Fairfield, IA cluster, there were no instances in which political advertising information was uploaded late to the online file after July 22.

Moreover, our review of the online public file revealed a late upload of the issues/programs lists for Q1 2018 for a station in the Fairfield, IA cluster. Alpha has not been able to determine the cause of this one-time delay. KMCD(AM) uploaded its Q2 2018 issues/programs list on September 24, 2020.

Finally, Alpha’s review of the Fairfield, IA cluster also indicated that both KMCD(AM) and KKFD-FM uploaded their 2019 EEO Public File Report approximately three months late and that both stations uploaded their 2018 EEO Public File Report on September 24, 2020 due to an administrative oversight.

Alpha will continue to monitor online public file compliance closely going forward.
