In one instance during the period covered by this Form 303-S, Core Programming aired by Station did not include the E/I symbol throughout the programming in accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.671(c)(5), and Station disclosed this issue in its Q1 2013 Form 398 (Children's TV Programming Report).

As explained in that Form 398, on March 23, 2013, there was a technical error in the network-wide graphics box (*i.e.*, the technology that is responsible for keying in the E/I logo over all children's educational programming) that prevented the THIS Network children's educational programming aired by the Station on that date from containing an E/I logo superimposition throughout the entirety of the programming. More specifically, although each of the relevant programs was identified by THIS Network as an E/I program to the suppliers of program guides, and each program was also introduced by an announcement stating that the following program "is an E/I program," the E/I logo failed to appear as a superimposition over each of the programs for their full durations due to the technical error. This technical error was confined to March 23, 2013 and did not reoccur.

Following discovery of the issue, THIS Network informed Station that the cause had been an inadvertent technical error and that the error had been corrected. Thereafter, the affected program episodes were aired in a rebroadcast in their second homes, and the rebroadcasts were publicized by announcements on THIS Network. The E/I logo was superimposed over each of the affected programs for the duration in these rebroadcasts.
