

Online Public Inspection File

Since Santamaria Broadcasting, Inc. (“Licensee”) became the licensee of KMNV(AM), St. Paul, Minnesota (Facility ID No. 99) (“KMNV”), on May 5, 2016,¹ Licensee failed to comply with certain Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements with respect to KMNV:

Section 73.3613 Contracts/Documents List. Licensee failed to upload to KMNV’s OPIF a list of the contracts/documents required by Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules by the requisite deadline. The list was subsequently uploaded to KMNV’s OPIF.

Issues/Programs Lists. Licensee failed to upload the Q2-Q4 2016, Q1-Q4 2016, Q1-Q4 2017, Q1-Q4 2018, Q1-Q4 2019, and Q1-Q3 2020 Issues/Programs Lists to KMNV’s OPIF by the requisite deadlines. The lists were subsequently uploaded to KMNV’s OPIF.

Political File Reports. During the applicable 2-year retention period, Licensee failed to upload several of its Political File Reports immediately to KMNV’s OPIF. All reports were subsequently uploaded to KMNV’s OPIF. Licensee will ensure in the future that it promptly complies with KMNV’s Political File reporting requirements in the future.

Licensee acknowledges that it missed the March 1, 2018 deadline for the initial setup of KMNV’s OPIF. Licensee intended to bring KMNV’s OPIF into compliance earlier this year. KMNV’s studio, however, burned down during the civil unrest in the Minneapolis metropolitan area in Summer 2020 – which further delayed Licensee’s efforts to bring KMNV’s OPIF up to date. Licensee will endeavor in the future to ensure that it complies timely and promptly with KMNV’s OPIF requirements.
