

## Issues/programs Lists

The Issues and Programs list for fourth quarter 2018 was filed late on January 28 2019. I prepare the I&A lists and filings both for Home Town Radio and for Timothy C. Cutforth. The landlord for the Timothy C Cutforth stations (KCEG AND KJME both licensed to Fountain, CO) tower site notified me late in October 2018 that I was ordered to vacate the tower site before November 1 2018. The necessity of filing for authority to remain dark, looking for an alternative tower site and the preparation of the I&A reports for KHTU, KJME, and KCEG overloaded me and I was surprised when I saw that the 10<sup>th</sup> had passed by quickly and I had missed the 10<sup>th</sup>. I put the report online on the 28<sup>th</sup>.

The KHTU Issues and Programs list for second Quarter 2019 was put on line late on July 11, 2019. This was my fault as I was having trouble keeping KHTU operating while I worked on the technical details of moving KCEG and KJME to a new tower site to resume service to Fountain, Colorado before the end of the one year drop dead time.

## Ownership reports.

The License and all assets are held by Home Town Radio a Colorado Not for Profit corporation. There are no agreements, documents, loans, LMA, JSA, or other pertinent agreements concerning the ownership or operation of the station and there never have been any such agreements.

## EEO

Timothy Cutforth substantially operates the station by himself under the direction of the board of directors and with the help of a few volunteers maintains the daily operation. There have never been 5 or more full time employees. As such the EEO report only must be filed at initial licensing and at renewal per the EEO form instructions.
