

PUBLIC INSPECTION FILE DOCUMENTS

Quarterly Programs-Issues lists for Q2 2013 and Q3 2013 were not placed in the online public file in a timely manner. Those two quarters were part of the mass upload when stations were required to transfer those files from the paper files, located at the studio, to their new public file online in 2018. Those two files were overlooked but were placed in the online public inspection file subsequently.

This year, and in the entire history of the station, there was only one (1) political advertising order for spots run on the station and that one (1) order was not uploaded in a timely manner to the station's online public inspection file. The station has been operated almost completely non-commercial since its existence so this not routine.

The station's operator has now been made aware of the importance of timeliness when placing these materials in the online public inspection and, in the future, will make sure that all political and issues advertising documents will be prepared and timely uploaded to the station's online public inspection file.
