LICENSE RENEWAL EXHIBIT

Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule

The applicant has responded in the negative to the certification that states: “Licensee certifies that during the preceding license term the station has not been silent (or operating for less than its prescribed minimum operating hours) for any period of more than 30 days.” Accordingly, the applicant provides the following additional information as to “the exact dates on which the station was silent or operating at less than its prescribed minimum operating schedule” and the surrounding context.

On September 11, 2019, the applicant’s TV translator W30EF-D (previously W25AY-D) went silent as a result of being displaced by full power station WJZY, Belmont, North Carolina, as part of the Phase 5 transition. On September 27, 2019—well within 30 days of W30EF-D going silent—the applicant filed for and the Commission granted a six-month Silent STA (LMS File No. [0000082354](#)). W30EF-D resumed operations on December 13, 2019, well before the expiration of the Silent STA.
