

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

The applicant in coordination with other users of the site is committed to reducing power or ceasing operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. Further, the Applicant commits to complying with any special operating conditions or restrictions listed on the construction permit which requires no action or specific response at licensing. Required responses to listed special conditions or restrictions are listed below.

- The filing of the instant application for license (FCC Form 2100, Schedule 350) allows for the commencement of program test operations and satisfies the listed special condition.
- The authorized technical facility uses an existing antenna system formerly used by W253AC (Facility I.D. 39873, now W230CQ) on the same frequency at the same location. There was no new construction necessary to implement the outstanding construction permit because the technical facility specified herein uses the existing antenna and the existing transmission line formerly used by W253AC and previously licensed under FCC File No. BLFT-20120202ABT. Because the implementation of the outstanding construction permit had no effect on co-located AM station, the construction permit's special operating condition should be considered moot or satisfied.
