### **Political File**

In preparation for filing its license renewal applications, NRG has conducted audits of the online public inspection files at its radio stations. Having become aware of deficiencies with respect to the timely upload of political advertising information in certain markets, NRG has redoubled the company's efforts to train staff consistently and to implement company-wide operating procedures so as to ensure that requisite information is timely uploaded to the online public file in compliance with the Commission's rules. NRG entered into a consent decree with the Commission on December 2, 2020 in connection with the license renewals of the company's Illinois and Wisconsin radio stations.

With respect to station KLIN, in 2019 7 political advertising agreements were uploaded timely, 5 were uploaded within 2 business days of the agreement and 4 were uploaded 3-14 business days after the agreement, one was uploaded more than 30 days after the agreement to purchase time due to some confusion with the order. In 2020, 50 agreements were uploaded within 24 hours, 5 were uploaded within 2 business days and 3 were uploaded within 3 business day and 1 was uploaded more than 30 days after the original agreement was signed.
