

DESCRIPTION

American Christian Television Services, Inc. (ACTS) requests a minor modification to relocate WOHW-LD to ASR tower #131217. WOHW-LD serves as a translator for WTLW programming carried on 4.1 and 4.2. The instant request constitutes a minor change because it does not request a change in WOHW-LD's frequency and, as reflected in the attached exhibit: (1) the proposed new transmitter site for WOHW-LD is less than 30 miles (48 kilometers) from the reference coordinates of WOHW-LD's existing antenna location; and (2) there is a significant overlap between WOHW-LD's existing contour and its proposed contour. See 47 C.F.R. § 74.787(b)(2).

With the proposed technical changes, WOHW-LD will better serve residents within Van Wert and greater Van Wert County, Mercer County, and Auglaize County, all of which have been part of WTLW's modified market since Special Relief was granted in 2001 (CSR-5733-A).

As an independent station, WTLW produces a significant amount of local programming unique to the City of Van Wert and surrounding communities. Much of this programming is related to education and arts and sports programming associated with the following school districts within the proposed service area: *Lincolnview, Crestview, Van Wert, Parkway, Celina, St. Henry, Coldwater, St. Marys Memorial, Wapakoneta, Waynesfield, Fort Recovery, Minster, New Bremen, Marion Local and Delphos Jefferson.*
