Dear Mr. Rice:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 27, 2020. RCA requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 17, 2018, to continue operating ND at night to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 license application after further action has been taken on the pending minor change construction permit application.¹ In support of the request, we estimate that further action will be taken on the pending application before the expiration date shown below.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RCA

may continue to operate ND at night with a maximum of 0.1 kW as proposed in the pending application, with no change to the daytime licensed 1 kW operation. RCA must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 3, 2020**.
