



- This instant application is a companion to a similar application for Translator K271BW to move to channel 269 and move to a distant tower location. Both K271BW and K269FZ will propose to rebroadcast the same primary station, and physical separation is required to be compliant with FCC duplication rules. The 2 translators are swapping channels to minimize potential for future full power co-channel interference to either translator.
- In compliance with 47 CFR 74.1204(g) the proposed facility operates at an effective radiated power which is not over 100 watts, therefore protection to intermediate frequency facilities has not been calculated.
- The proposed location is within the protected 60dbu (50,50) contour of second-adjacent station KZII-FM channel 273-c1 which is co-located on the same tower site. An interference analysis would be conducted based on the u/d ratio of +40 db at the proposed site and would demonstrate that the interfering contour between the 2 second adjacent facilities would be virtually immeasurably high and the interfering contour would be completely incapable of reaching the general public.
- Based on this showing, a waiver of section 74.1204 is requested in accordance with Living Way Ministries, Inc. (FCC 08-242) on the basis of zero population in the area of interference.
- It should be noted that should any actual real world interference occur, the applicant acknowledges that it will promptly suspend operation of this translator in accordance with 47 C.F.R. 74.1203.
