Multicast Disclosure

Nexstar Inc. (“Licensee”) is the licensee of WXSP-CD, Grand Rapids, Michigan (Facility ID 36851) RF Channel 15 (“WXSP”) and WOLP-CD, Grand Rapids, Michigan (Facility ID 167892) RF Channel 35 (“WOLP”). Each of WXSP and WOLP carry the same programming. Licensee proposes to (1) commence ATSC 3.0 operations from the current facilities for WXSP and WOLP; (2) transition its current WXSP and WOLP “.1” primary stream My Net programming to commonly owned station WOOD-TV, Grand Rapids, Michigan (Fac. ID 36838), RF Channel; (3) transition its current WXSP and WOLP “.2” COZI TV programming to WXMI(TV), Grand Rapids, Michigan (Fac. ID 68433), RF Channel 32, licensed to Scripps Broadcasting Holdings, LLC and (4) transition its current WXSP and WOLP “.3” Court TV Mystery programming to WWMT(TV), Kalamazoo, Michigan (Fac. ID 74195), RF Channel 8, licensed to WWMT License, LLC;. To comply with Commission requirements, applications for WOOD-TV, WWMT(TV) and WXMI(TV) to be carried in 3.0 format on WXSP are being filed contemporaneously with this application.

For clarity WXSP and WOLP channels will be hosted in 1.0 as follows:

Licensee is airing notices to over-the-air viewers of WXSP and WOLP that it intends to discontinue ATSC 1.0 operations and begin broadcasting in the NextGen TV standard on both the WXSP and WOLP channels beginning April 22, 2021, and to instruct all over-the-air viewers to tune to Channel 15 to continue receiving the programming in the ATSC 1.0 standard. MVPD notifications have been sent notifying all affected systems of these changes as well in compliance with the Commission’s rules.
