Online Public Inspection File

During the last license renewal term, Northwood Hispanic Communication Center (“Licensee”), licensee of KNLV, New Waverly, Texas (Facility ID No. 173796) (“KNLV”), has failed to comply with certain Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements with respect to KNLV.

Section 73.3613 Contracts/Documents List. Licensee inadvertently failed to upload the list of contracts and documents required by Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules to KNLV’s OPIF by the deadline. The list was subsequently uploaded to KNLV’s OPIF.

Issues/Programs List. Licensee inadvertently failed to upload its Q3 & Q4 2017, Q1-4 2018, Q1-4 2019, and Q1-4 2020 Issues/Programs Lists to its OPIF by the deadline. The lists have now been uploaded to KNLV’s OPIF and KNLV has held internal discussions regarding new procedures to ensure future lists are uploaded on time. The station employees who have responsibility for preparing and maintaining the documentation required to be uploaded to the OPIF have been reminded of the FCC’s requirements with respect to these matters and have implemented procedures to ensure that the required documentation will be placed in the station’s OPIF in a timely manner going forward.

Political File Reports. During the applicable 2-year retention period, documents with respect to two matters were uploaded late to KNLV’s OPIF Political Folder. All documents were subsequently uploaded to KNLV’s OPIF.
