

Online Public Inspection File

Licensee believes that the Online Public Inspection File ("OPIF") of WNDY-TV is substantially complete and that throughout the period of time covered by this application it substantially complied with the FCC's rules regarding the OPIF. Nonetheless, Licensee cannot certify that all required documents were uploaded to the OPIF in a timely manner. Specifically, Licensee failed to upload certification of compliance with the commercial limits in children's programming for 2020 and its EEO public file report for the period ending March 31, 2020 by the applicable deadlines; those documents were both subsequently added to the OPIF.

Licensee is also unable to certify that at all times it maintained an up-to-date list of the documents required to be maintained under Section 73.3613 of the Commission's rules, although Licensee believes that a current list of such documents was available in the Station's ownership reports during the majority of the time covered by this renewal application. A separate and complete list of Section 73.3613 documents is now available in the Station's OPIF.

Finally, Licensee also is unable to certify that during the applicable retention period all documentation required to be uploaded to the station's political file was uploaded in a complete and/or timely manner, although it believes that it substantially complied with the Commission's political file rules. Licensee will continue to review its procedures for posting to the online political file and will endeavor in the future to completely comply with WNDY-TV's Political File reporting requirements in a timely manner.
