

KXBJ Online Public Inspection File

During the last license renewal period, Hope Media Group (“Licensee”), licensee of KXBJ, El Campo, TX (Facility ID No. 36507) (“KXBJ”), cannot certify full compliance with KXBJ’s Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements.

Issues/Programs Lists. All issues-programs lists prior to the online public file transition were completed and placed in the paper file when due. However, KXBJ was a few months late in complying with the FCC’s March 1, 2018 deadline for the transition of non-commercial radio stations to the OPIF, thus the paper file uploads were late. Once Licensee migrated to the OPIF, only the Q1 2018, Q2 2018, Q3 2018, and Q4 2018 lists were not timely posted. All subsequent quarterly Issues/Programs Lists were timely posted and the OPIF is complete.

EEO Public File Reports. All EEO Public File Reports for the years prior to the online public file transition were completed and placed in the paper file when due. However, KXBJ was a few months late in complying with the FCC’s March 1, 2018 deadline for the transition of non-commercial radio stations to the OPIF. In addition, the 2014, 2018 and 2019 annual EEO Public File Reports were not timely posted.

EEO Mid-Term EEO Report. Licensee failed to submit its FCC Form 397 Mid-Term EEO Report.

Licensee appreciates its obligation to fully comply with the Commission’s rules. With the exception of the FCC Form 397 Mid-Term EEO Report, which cannot be filed at this time, all of the oversights listed above have been corrected and the KXBJ OPIF is now complete. Nonetheless, going forward, Licensee is committed to and will ensure full compliance with the Commission’s rules.
