KOMR(FM) Sun City, AZ (the "Station") believes that it has generally met the requirement in Section 73.1943(c) of the FCC rules to post political orders to the online public inspection file "immediately, absent unusual circumstances." The Station is not aware of any political spot for which it did not post information to the public inspection file. In an abundance of caution, the Station reports the following:

- In August 2020, the Station uploaded the intake form with information regarding a Non-candidate issue ad for Duty and Honor with information regarding the sponsor and issue addressed, but inadvertently failed to upload the contract with information regarding the rate paid. The contract was uploaded during the review for license renewal.
- In September 2020, the Station uploaded information regarding a candidate ad for Joe Biden 5 business days after the contract was finalized.
- Also in September, the Station uploaded information regarding two non-candidate issue ads in one instance 4 business days and the other 7 business days after the contract was finalized.
- In October 2020, the Station uploaded information regarding a candidate ad for Joe Biden 7 business days after the contract was finalized.
- Also in October, the Station uploaded information regarding two non-candidate issue ads in one instance 4 business days and the other 6 business days after the contract was finalized.
